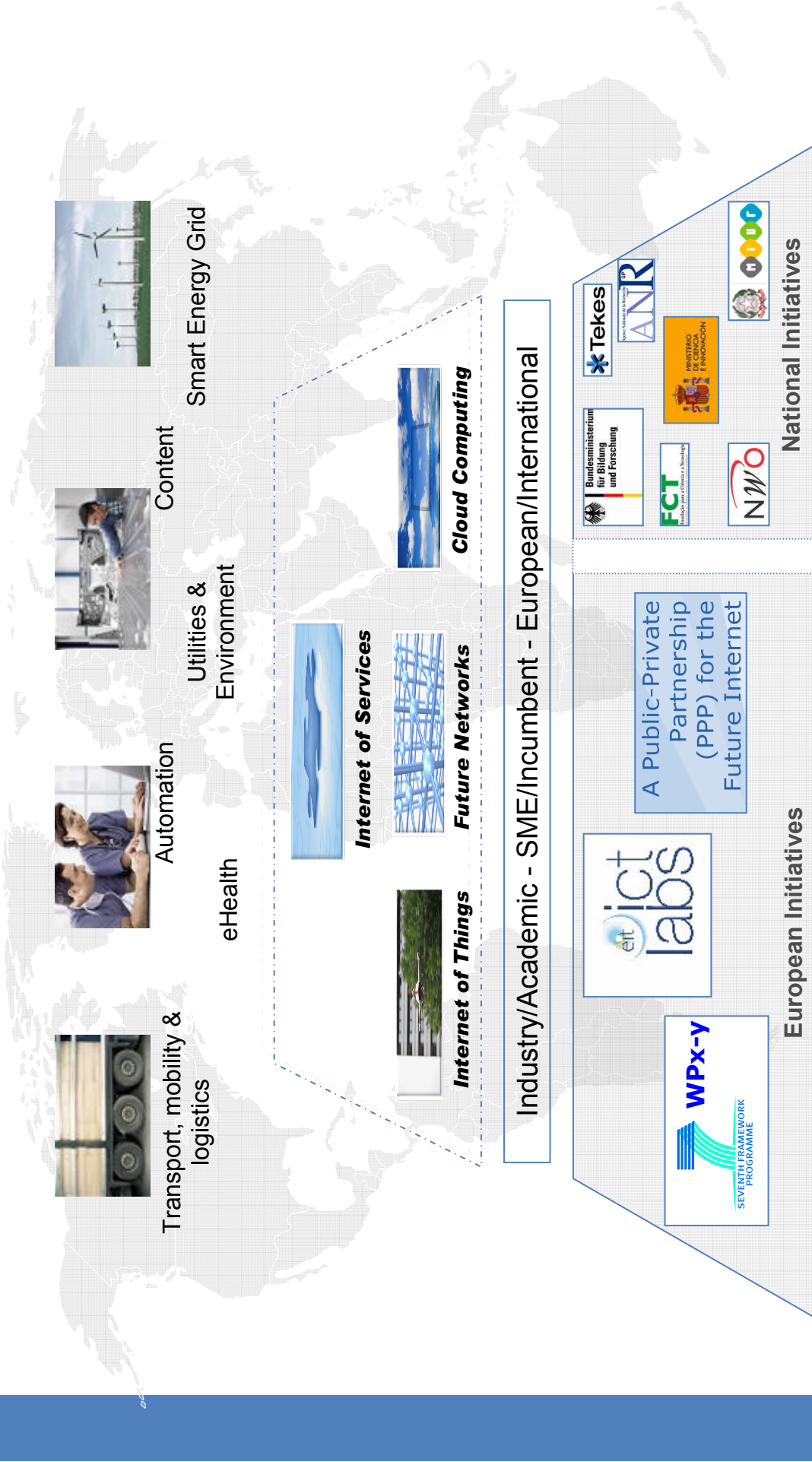

- Motivation

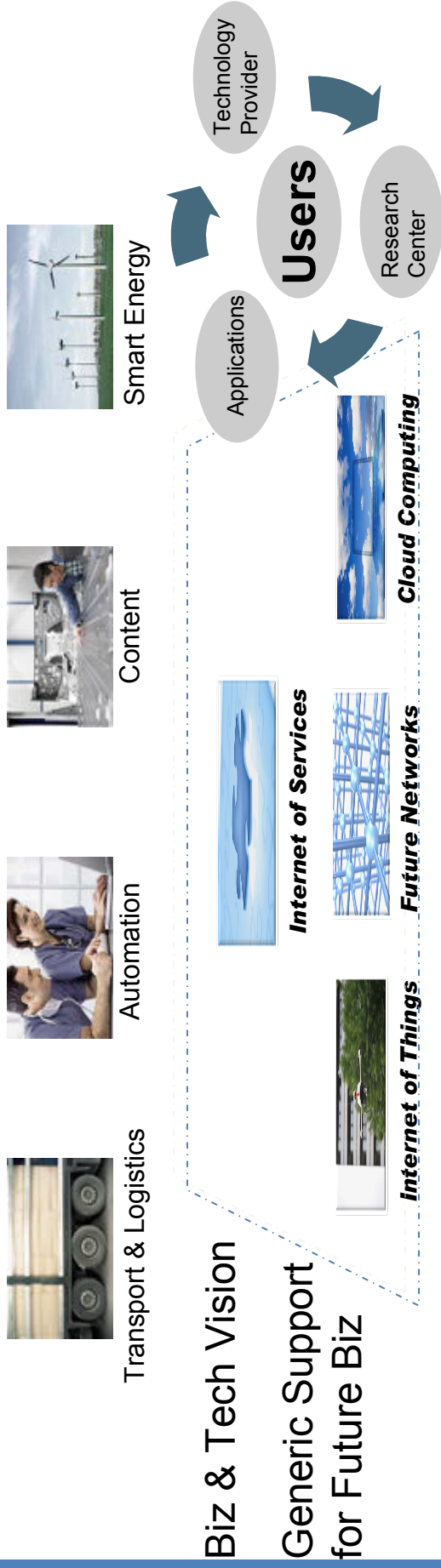
A few observations

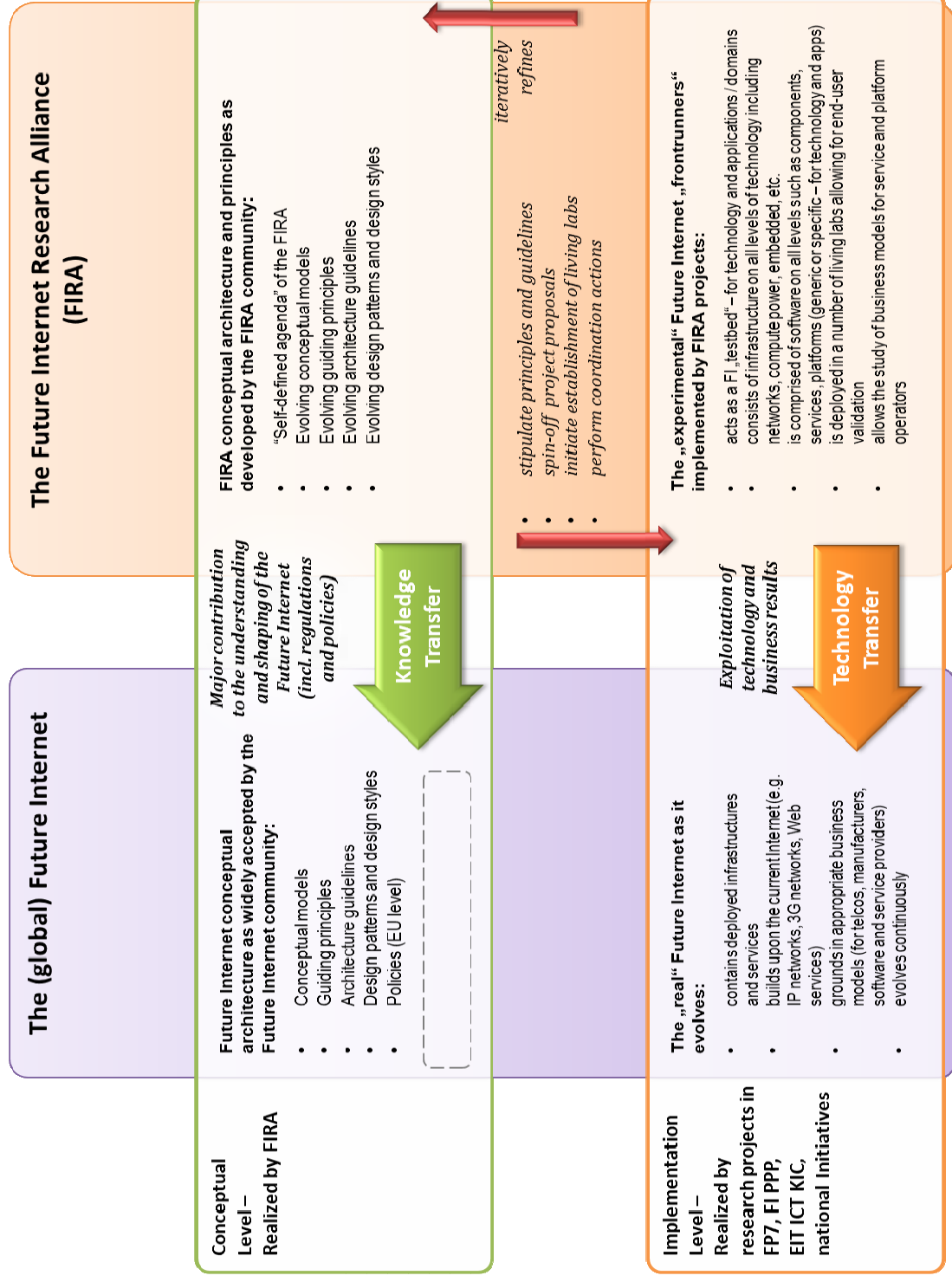

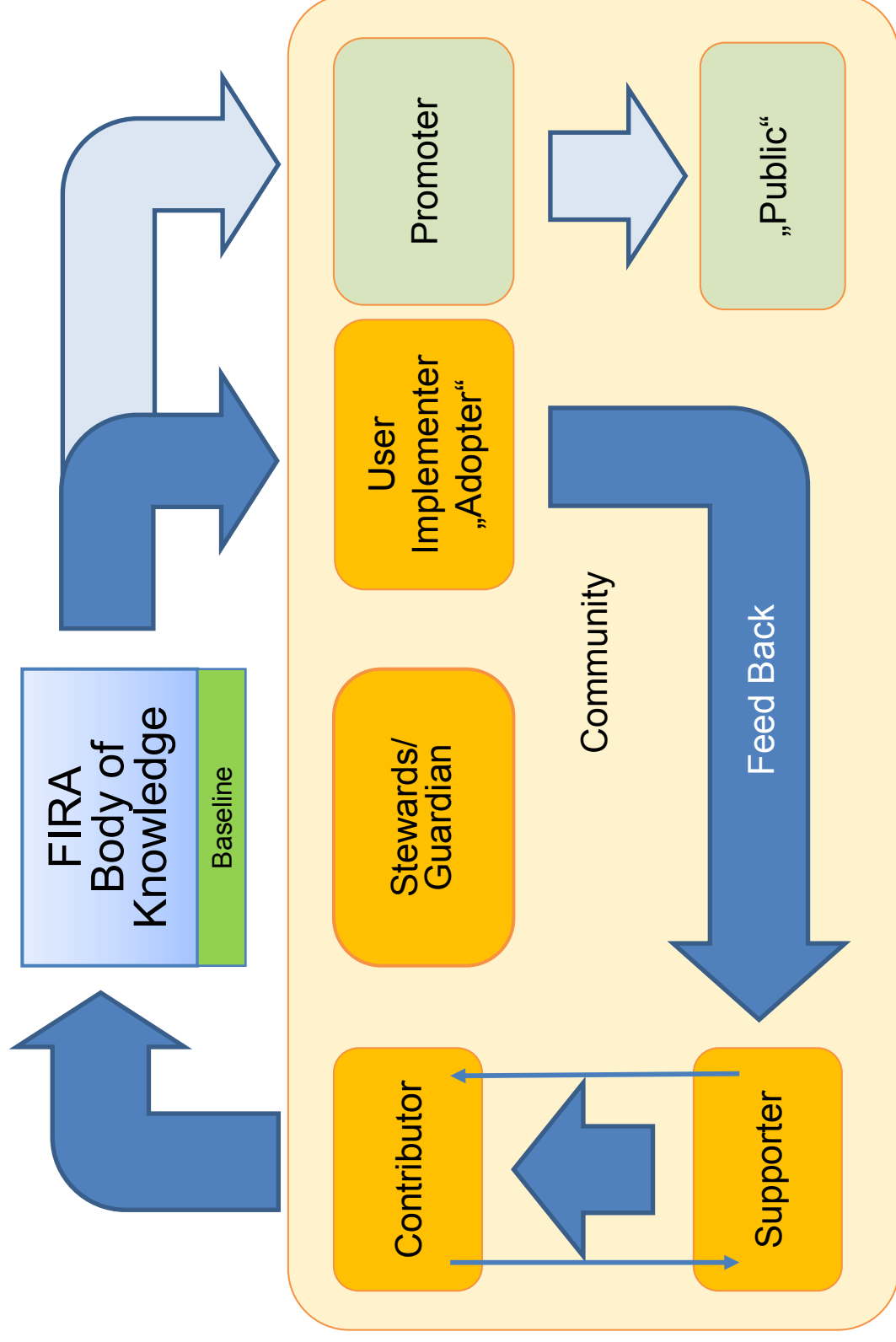

- Kick-off FIRA FI PPP activities (Core Platform, Use Cases, Governance)

Status

- FIRA Governance, first concepts established
 - FIRA Manifesto released (public since 20th of June)
- FIRA WG „FI Tech&Biz Vision“ created
 - Vision paper in progress (release: 5th of July)
- FIRA FI-PPP evaluation of partner interests
 - Strategy for call in progress
 - Selection of core seed projects from FP7

Next steps:

- Alignment with EIT - KIC-ICT Labs (F2F planned for July)
- Create working groups for FI PPP IPR, FI PPP Structure, FP8, and?
- Next F2F planned for mid/end of July
