- Auto-annotation of video, makes doctor patient dialogue during telepresence searchable.

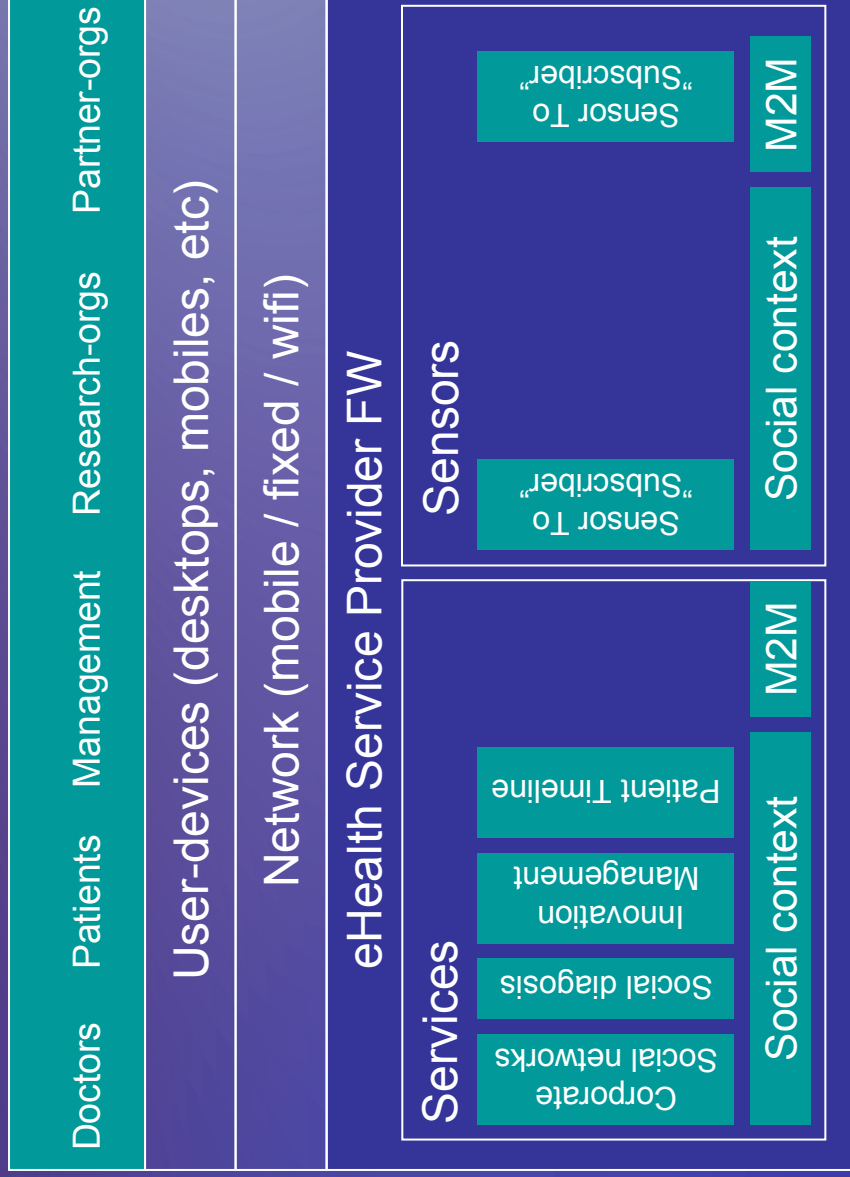
Core platform requirements
