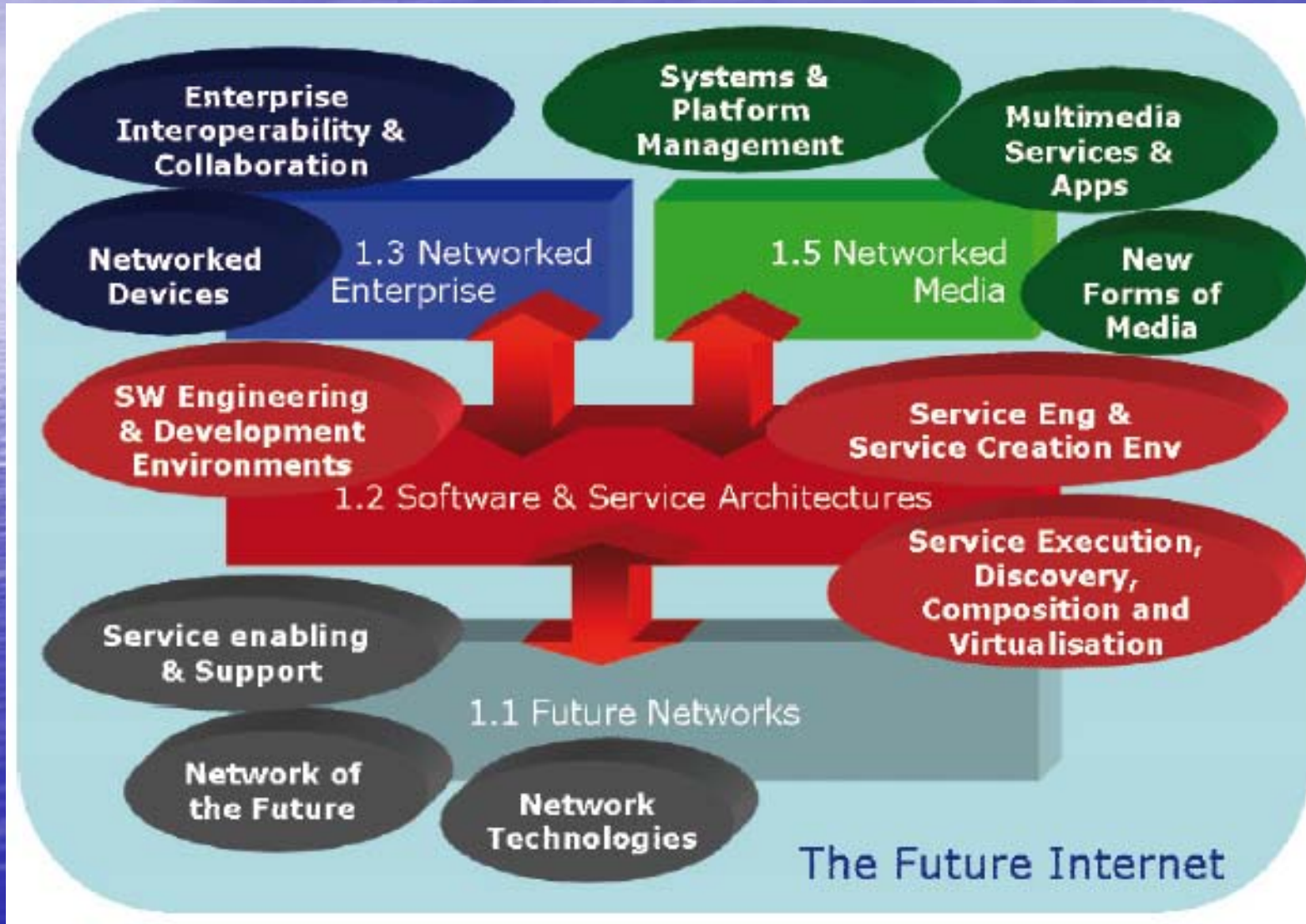

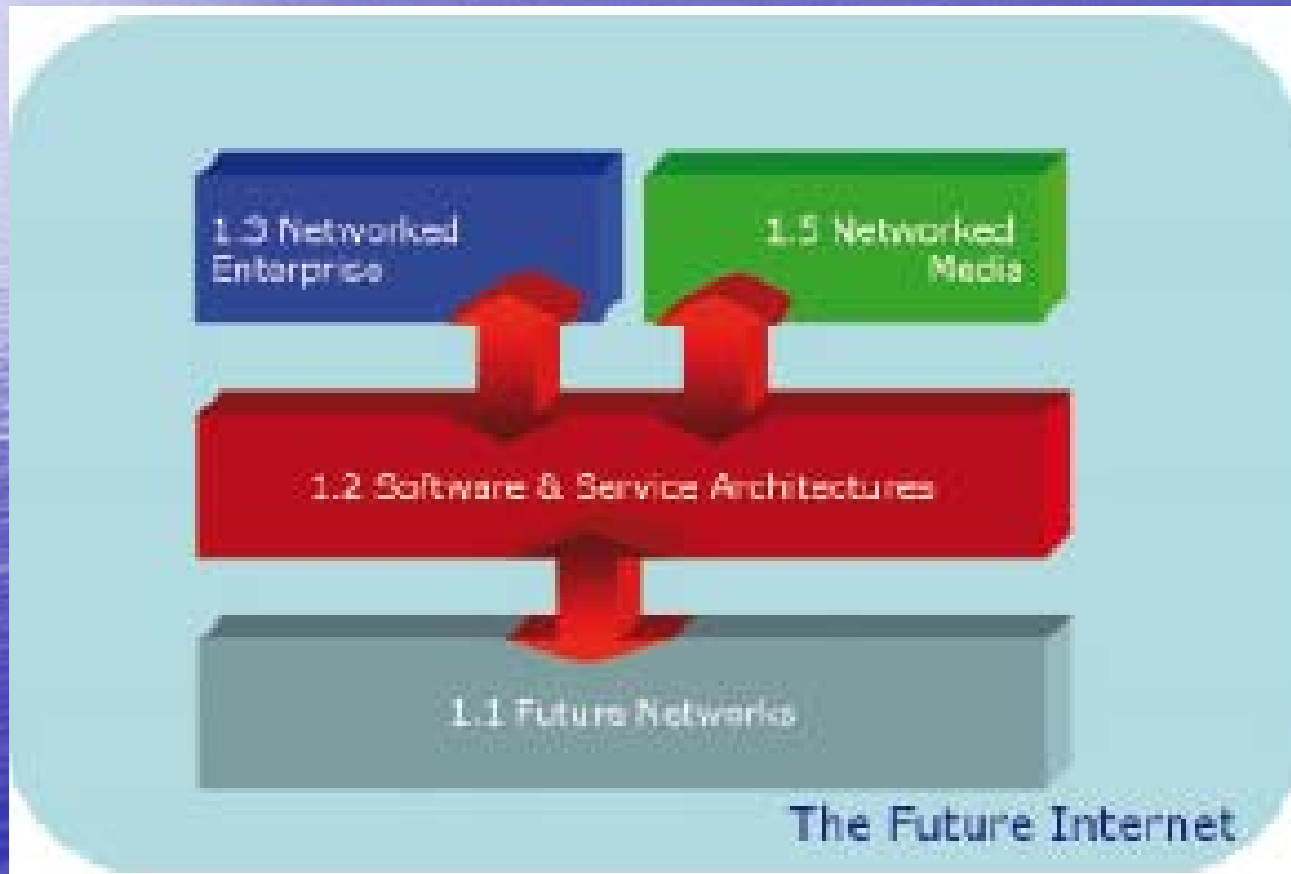

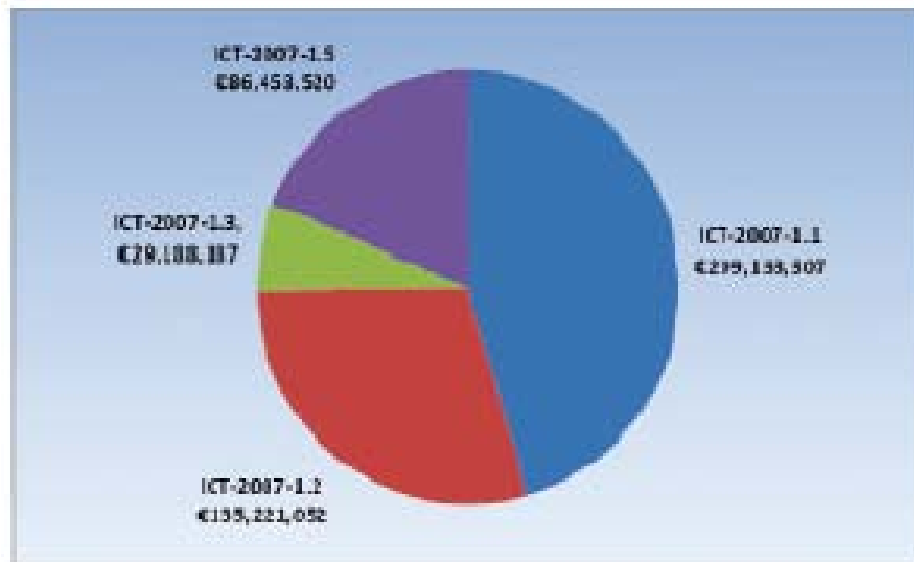


Figure I.1.2 Total EU Funding per Objective in Euro

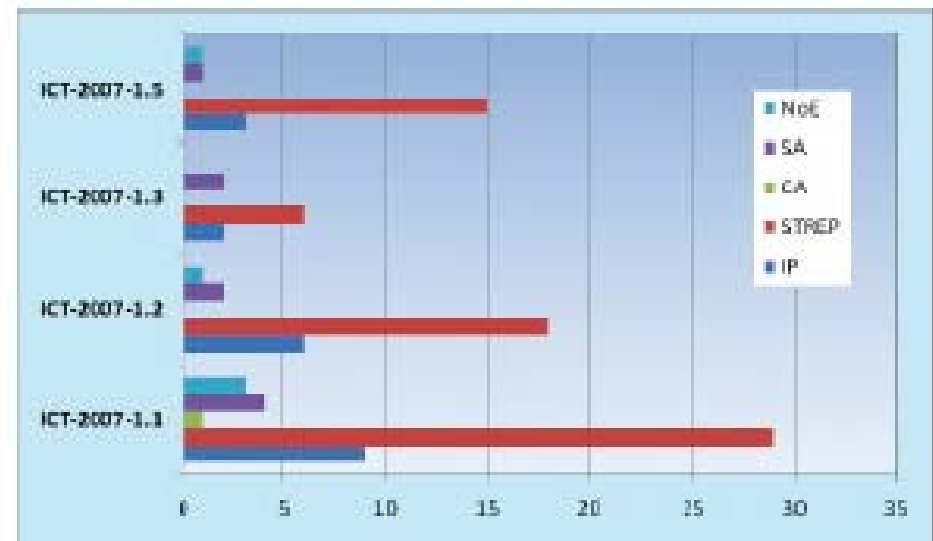


Figure I.1.5: Number of Projects per Objective

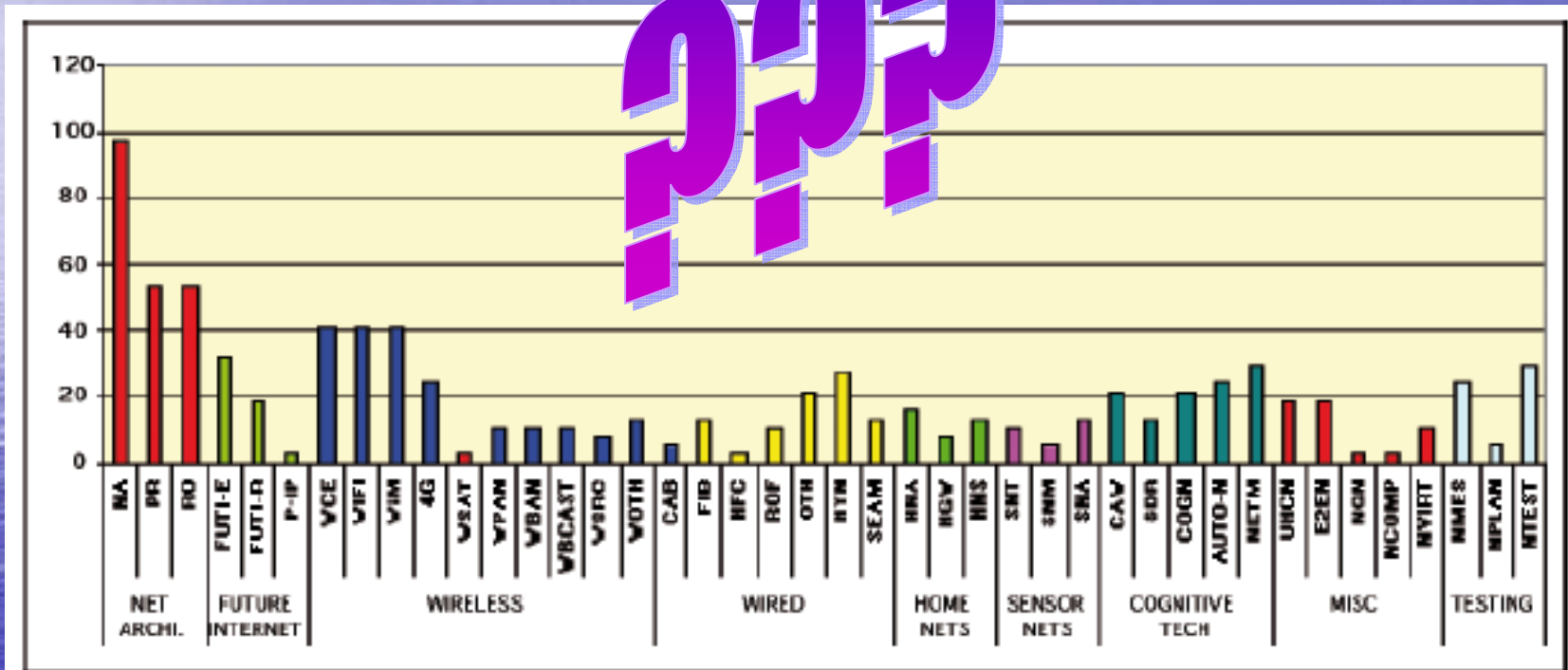


Figure 1.3: Percentage of Occurrence of Key Network Technologies
