Subject: Vision towards Future Media Internet

Scope (Max 5 lines text): Current networks and infrastructures for content and communication will be gradually replaced by the future Internet. Changing demographics, changing lifestyles, demanding educated consumers and media literate prosumers, and trends in globalization are driving forces for the exploitation of technological developments. Networked devices and Flexible Service Platforms have emerged as new R&D drivers. These changes affect the context and scope for R&D in the NEM domain dramatically. The major challenge that the NEM domain needs to envision for 2020 is derived from the magnitude with which the overall digital universe increases: much faster than 10-times-in-five-years. NEM 2020 vision positions will investigate some answers to this future needs.
