### **3. Breakout sessions in Valencia**

**Smart Health:** In this session speakers from the domain of Personal health systems and the virtual Physiological Human will present the applications they have in mind for the

**Economics of Information:** Digital information is now the enabler for creativity, innovation, decision making, economic output and enjoyment. The objective of this session is to understand the nature of digital information, how it can be used for societal and economic benefit, and how it is governed. **What does FI mean for enterprise:** The session will focus on:

- **Vision:** Smart Enterprises of the future and Innovation as a business routine
- **Business Models:** business models to support new value propositions and drive new business values
- **Future Internet Systems:** next generation systems that will support enterprises to innovate and thrive in the post-crisis landscape.
