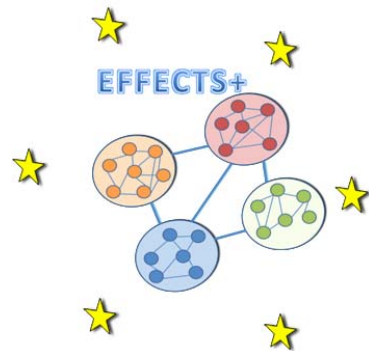

What are we going to do? (1 of 2)

- Promotion of the European FI activities through common portal
 - make benefits and achievements of European FIA projects known to relevant target groups including global visibility
 - target audiences include FP7 IPs, STREPS, SAs, KICs, EIT, CELTIC, EUREKA, industry, including NRENs, user community, policy makers at government and EU levels and the media

What are we going to do? (2 of 2)

- ❑ European vision on FI architecture
 - propose a European reference model for FI Arch
 - all projects and entities working on FI architecture can contribute
- ❑ Road mapping
 - attain a clear view of research challenges across the whole Future Internet space
 - make the known unknowns visible, including cross-domain challenges, and application driven challenges
 - FI(A) and FP8 Challenge 1 research community
 - research roadmap report updated yearly at major FIAs
- ❑ International collaboration and standardisation activities
